

REGULAR MEETING OF THE COUNCIL

OF THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM

November 27, 2007, at 9:30 A.M.

The Council of the City of Birmingham met in the Council Chambers of the City Hall of Birmingham on November 27, 2007 at 9:30 a.m., in regular meeting.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Father Philip Paxton, Priest of St. Mary's Catholic Church.

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Councilmember Smitherman made a motion to suspend the rules for a message from Councilmember Bell which motion was seconded by Councilmember Parker, and adopted.

Brendolyn High, Committee Assistant to Councilmember Bell presented his message. A moment of silent intercessory prayer was held for Councilmember Bell's recovery.

Mayor Langford spoke on the 23/23 Community Revitalization that began November 26, 2007. He also spoke on the slum lords within the City. A proposal will be submitted to the Council on the hiring of additional environmental officers and there will be no waivers on the pulling of dilapidated cars.

Mayor Langford spoke on the new proposal to increase lighting within the communities using the Alabama Power Company program.

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Mayor Langford spoke on turning the Boutwell Auditorium over to the Art Museum.

Mayor Langford spoke on demolishing Legion Field after the building of the Dome Stadium.

Mayor Langford spoke on the Birmingham Economic and Community Revitalization Ordinance.

Councilmember Montgomery arrived and assumed his seat as a Councilmember.

The Christmas Tree Lighting ceremony in Linn Park will be held December 4, 2007.

Mayor Langford announced that the entire City Hall is now wireless.

Councilmember Smitherman made a motion to suspend the rules for presentations which motion was seconded by Councilmember Parker, and adopted.

Councilmember Hoyt recognized Rev. Eddie Gibson, Associate Minister at Sardis Baptist Church who has aided in over 300 missionaries across the country. He and his wife were given the Outstanding Citizens Awards.

Minister Dwayne Thompson, Alabaster Alabama appeared relative to the National Stop the Violence Coalition which has been formulated.

Councilmember Duncan absented herself.

Councilmember Hoyt absented himself.

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Councilmember Smitherman recognized Neanta William, 444 Price Drive, representing the HIV Prevention Network who spoke on the upcoming Local Personality Church Ministers Basketball Tournament to be held Friday at Miles College. HIV Testing will be done at the event.

Councilmember Smitherman made a motion to suspend the rules for speakers which motion was seconded by Councilmember Abbott, and adopted.

Councilmember Hoyt returned and took his seat as a Councilmember.

Councilmember Duncan returned and took her seat as a Councilmember.

Alfred Thomas, Sr., 1523 Washington Street, Dolomite appeared relative to needing an update on the Dolomite Master Plan that has been on the books for over 15 years.

Councilmember Royal absented himself.

Dr. Artis Murphy, 1305 Avenue L, Ensley appeared relative to his own personal Community Code 3-5-1 and to ask the Council to support his efforts in literacy.

Alex Mitchell, 1305 Avenue L, Ensley appeared relative to aiding him to receive surgery after having been shot three (3) times in the Ensley area and the need for the police to help the youth instead of harassing them.

Willie Jenkins, 4008 29th Street North appeared relative to expressing well wishes to the Mayor, to announce that the District 4 Christmas Festival is December 6, 2007 at W. C. He also commended Carolyn Johnson in the program put on by Parents Against Violence, and to invite the Mayor and Council to his 53rd birthday on December 20th.

WHEREAS, the City of Birmingham has demonstrated the ability to utilize numerous public economic development programs to provide incentive for businesses to locate and expand within the City of Birmingham Urban Enterprise Zone; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Birmingham has sufficient infrastructure in place to accommodate additional industrial expansion and other public economic development programs; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Birmingham desires that the boundaries of the City of Birmingham Urban Enterprise Zone be expanded, and does hereby request that a revised City of Birmingham Urban Enterprise Zone map be accepted by the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs for the purpose of expanding the boundaries of the City of Birmingham Urban Enterprise Zone, to include and encompass the area described below (the “Expansion Area”); and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Birmingham hereby finds that the Expansion Area is a geographic area which is economically depressed and is in need of expansion of business and industry and the creation of jobs and is a target by the City of Birmingham for development by providing the benefits to private enterprise available through inclusion of the Expansion Area in the City of Birmingham Urban Enterprise Zone.

Section 1. That the Zoning District Map of the City of Birmingham as described in Section 2., "Zone Districts and Boundaries" of Title I of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Birmingham, (Ord. 90-130 as amended) be, and said Zone Map hereby is, amended by rezoning or redistricting the parcels of land hereinafter in this section described, so as to change such parcels from one class of districts to another class of districts as follows, to wit:

FROM: R-3, SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT

TO: "Q" B-1, QUALIFIED NEIGHBORHOOD BUSINESS DISTRICT

Located at 829 38th Street South, situated in the NW¹/₄ of Section 32, Township 17-S, Range 2-West (35222), being more particularly described as follows:

From the NW corner of the SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of said Section 32, run in a Southerly direction along the West line of said 1/4 - 1/4 section for a distance of 219.0 feet, more or less, to the Northwest corner of Lot 1, Map of Eloise Lockhart Dimick Subdivision, as recorded in the Office of the Judge of Probate, Jefferson County, Alabama, in Map Book 67, page 34, being an existing crimp iron pin

WHEREAS, citizens who live and work near the Screening Room testified to conditions suffered to exist at the business that spill into the neighborhoods and cause a detrimental and adverse effect on the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the immediate community, creating a nuisance to the community; and,

WHEREAS, such conditions include, but are not limited to, patrons of the business cruising and circling the area seeking sexual partners; cars occupied by persons who are engaged in sexual conduct outside residences and businesses in the area; trash and debris, including used condoms and beer cans, left outside residences and businesses; adverse impact on development and investment in the area due to the activities related to the business at the Screening Room; and,

WHEREAS, the owner of the Screening Room, having been given proper notice of the hearing, failed to appear before the Council to respond to the allegations made against the business

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and to exercise the right to be heard, to present evidence and to confront witnesses and evidence against the business in said public hearing; and,

WHEREAS, the Council heard substantial and credible testimony from the Birmingham Police Department, citizens and community leaders; and,

WHEREAS, the Council considered the evidence presented and finds that the owners, agents and employees of the business have operated in a way to allow, aid or abet violations of penal ordinances of the City and criminal laws of the State under color of such licenses and have created a situation which is detrimental to and immediately threatens the public health, safety and welfare of citizens of the community in which the business is located; and,

WHEREAS, the Council finds that it is in the best public interest of the City and the citizens of Birmingham that the business license for the Screening Room be revoked.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Birmingham, that the business license issued to the Screening Room, 2130 2nd Avenue, South, Birmingham, AL, 35233 is hereby revoked and canceled.
