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The Council of the City of Birmingham met in the Council Chambers of the City Hall of Birmingham on November 3, 2009 at 9:30 a.m., in regular meeting.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Reverend Dr. Morrell Todd, Pastor of First Baptist Church Acipco.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilmember Steven Hoyt.

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The minutes of May 12 and May 19, 2009 were approved as submitted.

Interim Mayor Smitherman presented Carol Hamilton of Birmingham, England with a proclamation and a key to the City of Birmingham, Alabama.

Interim Mayor Smitherman announced the resignation of Finance Director Steve Sayler.

Interim Mayor Smitherman announced a Task Force has been formed of business leaders, John McMann, Harvey Pressley, David Colvin, and Doug Turner of City Council to examine the city current financial status. Also the Birmingham Alliance has agreed to participate as well. The task force has been asked to report back within a week.

Interim Mayor Smitherman announced the City of Birmingham is in sound financial condition.

Interim Mayor Smitherman announced the current budget was under funded by 20 million dollars for essential city services.

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Interim Mayor Smitherman announced the Fair Park Project is on schedule and was under budgeted \$4.5 million dollars the revenue needed to fund the Family Fun Center.

**ORDINANCE NO. 09-162**

**WHEREAS**, BDL desires to increase the amount of fiber optic cable within the right-of-ways of the City in the City's corporate limits;

**WHEREAS**, City desires to permit BDL to increase the number of footage of the aerial and underground fiber optic cable under the same terms and conditions as the original contract;

**WHEREAS**, BDL and the City are currently in the renewal term of the original contract;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Birmingham, Alabama ("City"), that the Mayor is authorized to enter into the Second Amendment to Agreement with BDL that provides for amendments to Section 6 to change the location and number of linear feet of fiber optic cable in the rights-of-way of the City from 5904 feet to 6689

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and the number and location of pole attachments from 354 to 452 with the location of such fiber optic cable and pole attachments as are set forth in the amended Exhibit A: all other terms and provisions to the original Right-Of-Way Agreement dated January 8, 2008, to remain in full force and effect. The full text of Section 6 is amended to read as follows:

“6. BDL during the life of this Agreement agrees to pay to the City each July 1<sup>st</sup>, an amount equal to (i) Three Dollars (\$3.00) per linear foot of its facilities installed in those rights-of-way within the City in which more than four (4) public or private utilities have underground conduits in the City’s rights-of-way as of the effective date of this Agreement, and (ii) Two Dollars (\$2.00) per linear foot of its facilities installed in those rights-of-way within the City in which four or less public or private utilities have underground conduits in the City’s rights-of-way as of the effective date of this Agreement; (iii) and Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per pole attachment above ground or (iii) any right-of-way fee charged by the City now or in the future to all other similarly situated and like kind telecommunications providers. Currently, approximately 5904 linear feet of underground facilities and 354 pole attachments are installed in the City’s rights-of way. Effective November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2009, BDL shall increase its underground facility footage to 6689 and the number of pole attachments shall be 452 under the terms of this Agreement, and particularly described on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. However, any additional facilities may be installed hereunder upon prior written agreement of the parties. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein, the parties agree that no fee is due for any portion of the BDL’s conduit lying in the right-of-way owned by the U. S. Department of Transportation or the State of Alabama.

- A. Said fee shall be paid on an annual basis for each ensuing year to Department of Finance for the City of Birmingham.
- B. A prorated payment shall be made upon execution of this Agreement, for the period from the effective date of this Agreement to December 31, 2009. If this Agreement is terminated during the year, the City agrees to refund payments, without interest, on a prorated monthly basis. Should BDL fail to make the payments required by this paragraph, the City, at its option and subject to Section 13 (C) of this Agreement, by written notice may declare this Agreement canceled and terminated and all rights acquired hereunder by BDL shall thereupon terminate; provided however, the City may at its option determine to take title, rights and privileges to said fiber optic cable at no cost to the City or require BDL to be responsible for removing the said facilities installed pursuant to this Agreement from the City rights-of-way.”

Further the Exhibit A, being a written detailed description of the location of such fiber optic cable and pole attachments as set forth in the amended above stated Section 6 and pole attachment locations, with attached maps shall be amended as follows:

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“Exhibit A – Project Description and maps” – as attached hereto.

Project Description Birmingham Project 220E:

KDL is attached to Alabama Power Poles located within the City Limits of Birmingham as follows:

- (1). KDL is attaching to (16) Alabama Power poles starting at the intersection of 22Nd St N and 5Th Alley N, heading in a Northwesterly direction on 22Nd St N approx. 1452 ft to the intersection of 8Th Ave/US Hwy 78 and 22Nd St N.
- (2). KDL is attaching to (9) Alabama Power poles at the intersection 22Nd St N and 8Th Ave/US 78 going in a Northeasterly direction on 8Th Ave/US 78 approx 1053 ft to the intersection of 24Th St N and 8Th Ave/US 78.
- (3). KDL is attaching to (7) Alabama Power poles continuing in a Northwesterly direction on 24Th St N approx 814 ft to the intersection of 11Th Ave N and 24Th St N.
- (4). KDL is attaching to (6) Alabama Power poles at the intersection 24Th St N and 11Th Ave N heading In a Northeasterly direction on 11Th Ave N approx 1140 ft to the intersection of Carraway Blvd/ US 31 and 11Th Ave.
- (5). KDL is attaching to (37) Alabama Power poles at the intersection Carraway Blvd/US 31 and 11Th Ave N heading In a Northwesterly direction on Carraway Blvd/US 31 approx 4945 ft to the alley way Located between 20Th Ave N and 21Th Ave N.
- (6). KDL is attaching to (11) Alabama Power poles at the alley way located between 20Th Ave N and 21Th Ave N heading in a Northeasterly direction through the alley way approx 1342 ft to FL Shuttlesworth Dr.

**WHEREAS**, Act No. 105 of the Third Special Session of the Alabama Legislature, 1971, as amended by Act No. 87-728 of the Regular Session of the Alabama Legislature, 1987, and Act No. 89-380 of the Regular Session of the Alabama Legislature, 1989, and Act No. 91-192 of the Regular Session of the Alabama Legislature, 1991, provides that noxious or dangerous weeds growing upon private property in a municipality may be found and declared to be a public nuisance and the municipality may abate the nuisance and the cost of the abatement of said nuisance shall constitute a special assessment and create a lien against such private property: and

**WHEREAS**, the properties listed herein below in the City of Birmingham have growing upon them weeds which have attained such a large growth as to become a fire menace when dry and which are noxious and dangerous;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Birmingham that the real properties described herein below be and are hereby declared to be a public nuisance.

Fifty four years ago Reverend Crenshaw married the love of his life, Nellie Iona Crenshaw and to this union three daughters and three sons were born; and

**WHEREAS**, Reverend Crenshaw was a loyal servant in the ministry for 53 years and served as pastor of Broad Street Missionary Baptist Church for the past 49 years; and

**WHEREAS**, throughout Reverend Crenshaw's life-long tenure, he served as former president of the Birmingham Easonian Baptist Bible College and former president of the Birmingham Easonian Baptist Bible College Minister's Conference; he was an active member of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, the Mount Pilgrim District Association, Clergy That Care, the Alabama State Baptist Convention, the National Baptist Congress, the No. 4 District Conference for Christian Education and the Woodland Park Civic League; and

**WHEREAS**, Reverend Crenshaw also served as former PTA president at West Center Street Elementary School and later became the first African American PTA president at West End High School during the early days of integration; and

**WHEREAS**, Reverend Crenshaw, who will be truly missed by many, leaves to cherish his loving memories: a beloved wife, three sons, three daughters, seven grandchildren, and a host of cousins, in-laws, nieces and nephews;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Birmingham, with Acting Mayor Carole C. Smitherman concurring, that we hereby extend our heartfelt sympathies to the family of Reverend Solomon Crenshaw, Sr. during their time of bereavement.
