Sealed bids for ballistic vests, helmets and accessories for a period of one (1) year with month to month extensions thereafter upon mutual consent of both parties will be received by the Purchasing Agent, P-100 First Floor City Hall, Birmingham, Alabama until 2:00 p.m., September 9, 2015, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders wishing to bid can download the complete solicitation including the specifications and bid forms via the internet at www.birminghamal.gov (go to link titled Bidding Opportunities), or by visiting the Purchasing Office at the address shown above, or by calling (205) 254-2265, fax (205) 254-2484 and requesting a copy be mailed to you. Any addenda will be available on the internet. Bidder is responsible for checking the website for addenda until the bid opening date. Addenda will be mailed to only those vendors who were provided a copy in person or by mail.

It is required for any contract exceeding \$10,000.00 that the bidder submits with his bid a certified check, a cashier's check, or a bid bond payable to the City of Birmingham. In order for any bid award to be considered that exceeds \$10,000.00, your bid must be accompanied by an acceptable bid bond or check in the amount of \$500.00. Bid bond checks will be returned to all unsuccessful bidders after the formal award is made and to the successful bidder after acceptance of award. Should the successful bidder fail to accept the award, the bid bond check shall be forfeited.

The City follows a policy of nondiscrimination. No contractor with the City should discriminate on the basis of race, sex, religion or national origin. Failure by the Vendor to carry out these requirements is a material breach of its obligations, which may result in its termination or such other remedy as the City deems appropriate.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the date of the bid opening.

All bids are to be submitted on the bid form provided and all bids are to be f.o.b. Birmingham, Alabama delivered.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids submitted, in whole or part, and to waive any informalities.

Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope marked "**Ballistic Vests 2:00 PM, 09/19/15.**" Bids may be hand delivered to Room P-100 First Floor, City Hall, Birmingham, Alabama or mailed to City of Birmingham, P.O. Box 11295, Birmingham, Alabama 35202-1295. (DO NOT MAIL BIDS TO ROOM P-100 1ST FLOOR CITY HALL). However, bids sent by any express carrier (i.e. Federal Express, UPS, Airborne, etc.) must be shipped to 710 North 20th Street, and specify delivery to Room P-100, 1st Floor-City Hall.

It is the bidder's responsibility to make sure that his bid is in the possession of the Purchasing Agent on or before 2:00 p.m., September 9, 2015. Bids received after this time will not be considered.

**SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE SUPPLY OF BALLISTIC VESTS, HELMETS AND ACCESSORIES
FOR THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM**

GENERAL:

The City of Birmingham is seeking bids for ballistic vests and accessories. The basis of the bid shall consist primarily of any and all ballistic vests and accessories the City may require during the life of this contract. The City intends to award to the lowest priced, responsive, responsible bidder per group. The optional accessories for the vest(s) will only be a factor of award in determining the lowest bidder if selected at the time of award.

The proposed contract shall extend for a minimum time frame of one (1) year with month to month extensions thereafter at the prices originally bid upon mutual agreement of both parties. This extension phase is not to exceed twenty-four (24) months. Prior to the end of the initial contract year or during any extension phase of this contract, the successful bidder shall give the City an advanced thirty (30) days written notice if they wish to terminate the extension period. The life of this contract shall exist with the provision that no price increase in the original bid prices shall be allowed.

Municipalities are not liable for sales tax: reference Code of Alabama Section 40-23-4. Costs normally considered pass through costs (property tax, use tax, delivery charge, etc.) to the customer by the provider must be included in any fee proposed (Code of Alabama Section 40-12-222). For the purchase of personal property, the City's policy is to apply a local preference option, as allowed by State of Alabama Code, Section 41-16-50, in determining the low bidder.

The contract shall become effective from the date noted in the Notification of Award letter which will be mailed to the successful bidder.

The City will issue purchase order(s) to the successful bidder for the goods and/or services (bid items) that are the subject of the bid. Unless otherwise agreed in a writing that is signed by both parties, the entire agreement between the City and the successful bidder concerning the bid items is comprised of the terms, conditions, specifications and requirements stated in (a) the contemplated purchase order(s), (b) this Invitation to Bid and Specifications and (c) your bid (collectively, the "Contract Requirements"). These writings supersede all former proposals, offers, negotiations, representations or agreements, either written or oral, concerning the provision of vendor's goods and/or services. By acceptance of the City's purchase order(s), the successful vendor agrees to abide by and perform its responsibilities related to the bid items in compliance with the Contract Requirements.

Successful bidder shall not assign this contract to any other party without prior written approval of the City of Birmingham. Contract shall not be assigned to an unsuccessful bidder who was rejected because he was not a responsive or responsible bidder.

Any bid that imposes a service fee or any other type of fee on any order not exceeding a minimum order quantity or minimum purchase order dollar amount, will be determined a non-responsive bid and will not be considered for award.

Any bid that stipulates a reversal of freight charges if a minimum quantity or purchase order amount is not ordered will be determined a non-responsive bid and will not be considered for award.

Failure to adhere to any or all terms, conditions and specifications as set forth in the contract may result in the immediate termination of the contract. Should termination occur, the holder of the contract may be declared a "non-responsible vendor". This declaration may result in the rejection of any future bids submitted by the vendor for a period of time to be determined by the City.

All bids submitted are to be F.O.B. delivered, City of Birmingham, Birmingham, AL.

It is required for any contract exceeding \$10,000.00 that bidder must submit with his/her bid either a certified check, a cashier's check, or a bid bond payable to the City of Birmingham. In order for any bid award to be considered that exceeds \$10,000.00, your bid must be accompanied by an acceptable bid bond or check in the amount of \$500.00. Bid bond checks will be returned to all unsuccessful bidders after the formal award is made and to the successful bidder after acceptance of award. Should the successful bidder fail to accept the award, the bid bond check shall be forfeited.

The City's standard payment term is Net-30 Days from acceptance. Exception may be allowed for discounted early payment, such as 2%-10, Net 30 Days. The reference date for all such discounted early payment terms will be the date the invoice is received or the date the goods are received, whichever is later. In the event of a dispute the City's records shall prevail. **The City will not consider any bids requiring C.O.D. payments.**

The quantities shown on the bid form are estimated initial purchase quantities only. Merchandise shall be ordered as requirements dictate. The City reserves the right to purchase more or less than this quantity as conditions require, and no bidder shall attempt to hold the quantities shown as a firm quantity under this contract.

Bids may be solicited for the product included in this contract where an immediate/emergency need exists including large quantities. The decision of the Purchasing Agent as to what constitutes a biddable situation shall be final and shall not be construed as a breach of contract.

Any questions concerning these specifications should be addressed to Purchasing Division, Charles Lindsey, phone (205) 254-2269, fax, (205) 254-2484, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Vendor (and its employees, agents and any subcontractors) shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, or sex in the performance of the services contemplated hereunder. Failure by the bidder to carry out these requirements is a material breach of its obligations, which may result in its termination or such other remedy as the City deems appropriate.

Vendor acknowledges and agrees that, consistent with federal law and City's public policy, it will encourage disadvantaged business enterprise (DBE) participation to the extent permitted by law. A "disadvantaged business enterprise" is a for-profit small business concern (i) at least 51% owned by one or more individuals who are both socially and economically disadvantaged or, in the case of a corporation, in which 51% of the stock is owned by one or more such individuals; and (ii) whose management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more of the socially and economically disadvantaged individuals who own it. In accordance with federal law, a "socially and economically disadvantaged individual" includes African-Americans, Hispanic Americans, Native Americans, Asian-Americans, women, and any additional groups designated as socially and economically disadvantaged by the federal Small Business Administration.

Successful bidder acknowledges and agrees that the City has the right to deduct from total amount of consideration to be paid, if any, to the successful bidder under this agreement all unpaid, delinquent, or overdue license fees, taxes, fines, penalties, and other amounts due the City from the successful bidder.

Any successful bidder who is not currently set up as a vendor in the City of Birmingham vendor file will be required to submit a completed W-9 tax form prior to any award. The W-9 tax form may be submitted with your bid or no later than seven (7) working days of receipt of notice of intent to award.

The City of Birmingham must have a copy of the successful bidder's current City of Birmingham business license prior to formal award of contract. Each bidder may submit a copy of his/her license along with his/her bid. However, bidder must provide a copy of his/her current business license no later than seven (7) working days of receipt of notice of intent to award. Failure to submit the requested information will result in the notice of intent to award being revoked.

Successful Vendor (located in the State of Alabama or located outside of the State of Alabama, but employs one or more employees within the State of Alabama) represents and warrants that it does not knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an "unauthorized alien", as defined by the Beason-Hammon Alabama Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act, Act No. 2011-535 (H.B.56) of the Alabama Legislature, as amended from time to time (the "Act") and that, during the performance of this contract, Vendor shall participate in the E-Verify program as required under the term of the Act. Vendor agrees to comply with all applicable provisions of the Act. As a condition for the award of any contract, Vendor shall provide documentation establishing that the Vendor is enrolled in the E-Verify program, or a signed, written statement that the Vendor does not have a presence (one or more employees) in the State of Alabama. Vendor may submit applicable documentation with his/her bid or no later than seven (7) working days of receipt of notice of intent to award.

SCOPE:

This scope of this product specification provides information relating to the T1 – Defcon Model Number: XP3A-10 Tactical Carrier and accessories manufactured by Covert Armor International or equal.

Models numbers are given for reference and are to be descriptive rather than restrictive. Bid the following units or equal. Units bid as “equal or better” must be accompanied by brochures, catalogs, or technical specifications demonstrating that the unit is equal or better than the model number provided. All bidders must provide documentation clearly indicating the Brand, Model, NIJ Certification Letter, Independent Ballistic Test Reports, Drawings, Diagrams and Technical Specifications supporting the proposed products ability to meet the stated minimum requirements.

The following product specification details the quality and design of armor systems intended for use by law enforcement officers of this agency. The armor system shall be designed for Tactical Outer wear over the officer’s shirt. All armor systems being offered or presented shall meet or exceed the minimum performance requirements of NIJ 0101.06 dated July 2008 for the specified threat level and any additional performance or design requirements set forth throughout this specification. If the bidder is offering a different model, a full sample including plates, must be supplied with the bid.

IMPORTANT: Comfort and wearability of this garment are paramount considerations in the evaluation of any body armor bid. Superior ballistic characteristics are extremely important, but only if the armor is worn. Officers will not wear body armor that is not comfortable or restrictive as relates to allowing the officers to perform routine functions due to poor wearability of any body armor bid.

Fit, Finish and Coverage: Vests are to be fitted to the individual wearer in accordance with generally accepted sizing practices. Vendor shall provide a listing of all the sizes normally considered stock/off-the-shelf sizes which will be available for emergency requirements. Measurements shall be taken at locations to be provided by the Birmingham Police Department. On-site measurements must be coordinated with the Police Department and bidder shall be available within five (5) calendar days of notification to provide measuring service for the term of the contract. The patterning system shall have design parameters to provide for properly fitting “average, athletic and portly build” individuals.

BIDDER COMPLIANCE FORMAT

Bidders shall check (✓) each and every paragraph in the appropriate column provided on the right hand edge of the page as to compliance or non-compliance with specifications. Exceptions will be allowed to items that are not listed as “No Exception” if they are equal to or superior to that specified and provided they are listed and fully explained on the exceptions page. The purchaser shall be the sole judge of equality and the decision of the City of Birmingham shall be final. Bids taking total exception to the specifications will not be accepted.

TRACEABILITY OF RAW MATERIALS		
All ballistic and critical materials shall have lot traceability for all individual vests and orders from the concealable body armor system manufacturer to the fabric producer on ballistic panel cover materials and to the fiber supplier on ballistic materials.
