INVITATION TO BID #16-09

Sealed bids for leasing of approximately one (1) automobile for the City of Birmingham will be received by the Purchasing Agent; P-100 First Floor City Hall, Birmingham, Alabama until 2:00 p.m., February 24, 2016, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders wishing to bid can download the complete solicitation including the specifications and bid forms via the internet at www.birminghamal.gov (go to link titled Bidding Opportunities), or by visiting the Purchasing Office at the address shown above, or by calling (205) 254-2265, fax (205) 254-2484 and requesting a copy be mailed to you. Any addenda will be available on the internet. Bidder is responsible for checking the website for addenda until the bid opening date. Addenda will be mailed to only those vendors who were provided a copy in person or by mail.

Bids are to be submitted on the bid form provided, and all quotations are to be f.o.b. Birmingham, Alabama delivered.

A certified check, cashier's check or acceptable bid bond, in the name of the bidder and made payable to the City of Birmingham in the amount of \$500.00 must accompany the bid. Bid bond checks will be returned to all unsuccessful bidders after the formal award is made and to the successful bidder after acceptance of award. Should the successful bidder fail to accept the award, the bid bond or check shall be forfeited.

The City follows a policy of nondiscrimination. No contractor with the City should discriminate on the basis of race, sex, religion or national origin. Failure by the Vendor to carry out these requirements is a material breach of its obligations, which may result in its termination or such other remedy as the City deems appropriate.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the date of the bid opening.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids submitted in whole or in part, and to waive any informalities.

Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope marked, **SEALED BID – LEASE AUTOMOBILES, 2:00 P.M., 02/24/16.** Bids may be hand delivered to Room P-100 First Floor City Hall, Birmingham, Alabama or mailed to City of Birmingham, P.O. Box 11295, Birmingham, Alabama 35202-1295. **(DO NOT MAIL BIDS TO ROOM P-100 1ST FLOOR CITY HALL)**. However, bids sent by any express carrier (i.e. Federal Express, UPS, Airborne, etc.) must be shipped to 710 North 20th Street, and specify delivery to Room P-100, 1st Floor-City Hall.

It is the bidder's responsibility to make sure that his bid is in the possession of the Purchasing Agent on or before 2:00 p.m., February 24, 2016. Bids received after this time will not be considered.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR LEASE OF NEW FULL SIZE VEHICLE

All items of cost are to be included in the lease price bid. Municipalities are not liable for sales tax: reference Code of Alabama Section 40-23-4. Costs normally considered as pass through costs (property tax, use tax, delivery charge, etc.) to the customer by the vendor must be included in the bid price in accordance with Section 40-12-222 Code of Alabama. Absolutely NO additional costs will be allowed or paid during the term of the contract.

Successful bidder shall not assign this contract to any other party without prior written approval of the City of Birmingham. Contract shall not be assigned under any conditions to an unsuccessful bidder who was rejected because they were not a responsive/responsible bidder.

The City will issue purchase order(s) to the successful bidder for the goods and/or services (bid items) that are the subject of the bid. Unless otherwise agreed in a writing that is signed by both parties, the entire agreement between the City and the successful bidder concerning the bid items is comprised of the terms, conditions, specifications and requirements stated in (a) the contemplated purchase order(s), (b) this Invitation to Bid and Specifications and (c) your bid (collectively, the "Contract Requirements"). These writings supersede all former proposals, offers, negotiations, representations or agreements, either written or oral, concerning the provision of vendor's goods and/or services. By acceptance of the City's purchase order(s), the successful vendor agrees to abide by and perform its responsibilities related to the bid items in compliance with the Contract Requirements.

The City's standard payment terms are net 30 days from acceptance. Exception may be allowed for discounted early payment, such as 2% 10 net 30 days. The City will not consider any bids requiring C.O.D. payments.

Bids are to be submitted on the bid form provided, and all quotations are to be f.o.b. Birmingham, Alabama delivered.

Contract award to purchase the materials covered in this bid document shall be construed under and governed by the laws of the State of Alabama and each party hereto irrevocably agrees to be subject to the jurisdictions of the courts of the State of Alabama.

An acceptable non-appropriation of funds clause must be include in any contract where the term of the contract overlaps the City's fiscal year (July 1 thru June 30) or would extend for a term greater than one year.

Failure to adhere to any or all terms, conditions and specifications as set forth in the contract may result in the immediate termination of the contract. Should termination occur, the holder of the contract may be declared a "non-responsible vendor". This declaration may result in rejection of any future bids submitted by the vendor for a period of time to be determined by the City.

DELIVERY: Full size vehicle is to replace one (1) unit whose lease has expired. Therefore, time is of the essence. Any extended delivery dates will not be considered.

The City reserves the right to lease automobiles at a later date at the bid price if mutually agreeable to the City and the successful bidder. Award will be based on the lowest priced responsive, responsible bid submitted per line item.

Vendor (and its employees, agents and any subcontractors) shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, or sex in the performance of the services contemplated hereunder. Failure by the Vendor to carry out these requirements is a material breach of its obligations, which may result in its termination or such other remedy as the City deems appropriate.

Vendor acknowledges and agrees that, consistent with federal law and City's public policy, it will encourage disadvantaged business enterprise (DBE) participation to the extent permitted by law. A "disadvantaged business enterprise" is a for-profit small business concern (i) at least 51% owned by one or more individuals who are both socially and economically disadvantaged or, in the case of a corporation, in which 51% of the stock is owned by one or more such individuals; and (ii) whose management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more of the socially and economically disadvantaged individuals who own it. In accordance with federal law, a "socially and economically disadvantaged individual" includes African-Americans, Hispanic Americans, Native Americans, Asian-Americans, women, and any additional groups designated as socially and economically disadvantaged by the federal Small Business Administration.

Successful bidder acknowledges and agrees that the City has the right to deduct from total amount of consideration to be paid, if any, to the successful bidder under this agreement all unpaid, delinquent or overdue license fees, taxes, fines, penalties and other amounts due the City from the successful bidder.

City of Birmingham must have a copy of the successful bidder's current City of Birmingham business license prior to formal award of contract. Each bidder may submit a copy of his/her license along with his/her bid. However, successful bidder must provide a copy of his/her current business license no later than 7 working days of receipt of notice of intent to award. Failure to submit the requested information will result in the notice of intent to award being revoked.

Any successful bidder who is not currently set up as a vendor in the City of Birmingham vendor file will be required to submit a completed W-9 tax form prior to any award. The W-9 tax form may be submitted with your bid or no later than seven (7) working days of receipt of notice of intent to award.

Successful Vendor (located in the State of Alabama or located outside of the State of Alabama, but employs one or more employees within the State of Alabama) represents and warrants that it does not knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an "unauthorized alien", as defined by the Beason-Hammon Alabama Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act, Act No. 2011-535 (H.B.56) of the Alabama Legislature, as amended from time to time (the "Act") and that, during the performance of this contract, Vendor shall participate in the E-Verify program as required under the term of the Act. Vendor agrees to comply with all applicable provisions of the Act. As a condition for the award of any contract, Vendor shall provide documentation establishing that the Vendor is enrolled in the E-Verify program, or a signed, written statement that the Vendor does not have a presence (one or more employees) in the State of Alabama. Vendor may submit applicable documentation with his/her bid or no later than seven (7) working days of receipt of notice of intent to award.
