



The City of Birmingham is continuing its efforts to go green and to promote good housekeeping for the good of the city!!!



City's Stormwater Management Section of the Department of Planning, Engineering, and Permits is working in partnership with the Mayor's Office and City departments to establish standard operating procedures for pollution prevention at all City Facilities.

Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) is a site-specific program that: Identifies potential sources of stormwater pollution at the industrial facility; describes stormwater control measures that are used to reduce or eliminate pollutants in stormwater discharges from the industrial/ municipal facility; and identifies procedures the operator will use to comply with the terms and conditions of State General Industrial Stormwater permit.



The Stormwater Management Section, with assistance from Occupational Health and Safety, will train all facility staff in the proper storm water system usage as well as development of SWPPPs. Each municipal facility (with industrial activity) should have a site specific plan. All facility staff will have a role in developing and implementing the SWPPP.

What's required in the SWPPP?

- *Must describe the Coordinator*
- *Must describe the Facility*
- *Must describe any "Exposed" activities*
- *Must include the Site Map*
- *Must describe the Materials & Activities*



- *Must describe the Practices To Control Pollutants*
- *Must describe the Procedures For Evaluation Of Compliance*
- *Must be Approved & Implemented*
