The Eastern Area Landfill is an existing municipal solid waste landfill located on 370 acres off of Alton Road in eastern Jefferson County. The City has previously received host government approval to dispose waste within 48 acres at the Eastern Area Landfill. The City proposes that the host government remove the disposal acreage restriction, allowing the City to potentially use the entire acreage for disposal, subject to regulatory limitations and approval by the Alabama Department of Environmental Management for development of disposal units within the acreage in accordance with the requirements of 40 CFR Parts 257

and 258 (“Subtitle D”); Ala. Admin. Code r. 335-13; and, the City of Birmingham Solid Waste Management Plan. The landfill is currently permitted by the Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM). The proposed modification is relevant to and consistent with the City of Birmingham Solid Waste Management Plan.
