CDBG-R Critical Repair Grant Program	Provision of grants of eligible rehabilitation expenses to low-and moderate income homeowners up to \$5,000 per qualified homeowner for the rehabilitation of single family structures. The primary objective of this program is to deter neighborhood deterioration in Birmingham by providing incentives for rehabilitation of the residential housing stock which can be restored by moderate investment. The program is designed to restore housing before the costs of such repairs become prohibitive and more drastic action, such as demolition, becomes necessary. All rehabilitation is to be performed by licensed contractors of the eligible homeowners selection. It is estimated 320 housing units can be assisted.	24 CFR 570.202, eligible rehabilitation and preservation activities.	24 CFR 570.208(a)(3), Housing Activities.
