



Court Security helps to maintain peace and ensures that the general public is safe. The entry points at David Vann is monitored by a walk-through model and complimented with a Magnometer (wand). This process is more expedient to get the defendants to their proper courtroom and/or destination in the facility. In order to be effective, there are a number of things we must do and they are as follows:

1. Defendants will not be allowed in the building if they do not adhere to the Dress Code Policy.
2. Upon search, defendants must remove all items from their pockets.
3. Purses will be searched and large bags are not permitted in the building.
4. Weapons and/or contraband are not allowed in the building.
5. Upon entrance defendants will be scanned or wand at the security desk.
