Birmingham residents are permitted to dump at the Eastern Area Landfill's Public Unloading Area, which is a cement pad where residents can drive their vehicles for drop off.

To be eligible for drop offs, individuals must show a driver's license, proving they live in Jefferson County.

There is no fee for residential disposal.

The Public Unloading Area accepts:

- Bagged household garbage and rubbish (refuse & litter), plastic appliances, furniture, TVs, and other similar type materials
- One computer per household
- Recyclable scrap metal: copper, aluminum, stainless steel, steel, tin, cast iron, cans, and old metal appliances are collected and transported to a local metal recycler for processing
- Recyclable paper (bagged or boxed) newspaper, office paper, magazines, books, etc.
- Recyclable plastics: soft drink/water bottles, fruit juice containers, cooking oil/salad dressing containers, milk jugs, cleaning agents, laundry detergent containers, bleaching agent containers, shampoo and conditioner bottles, and washing and shower soap containers.

The Public Unloading Area DOES NOT accept:

- Liquids or hazardous solid waste
- Compressed air containers
- Fluorescent bulbs, wooden doors, wooden pallets
- Paint, tires, batteries
- Mattresses
- Construction and demolition waste (toilets, pipes, roofing, siding, ceiling tiles, carpet & flooring, insulation, etc.)
- Bulk trees & brush

What is illegal dumping?

Illegal dumping is defined as the act of knowingly placing waste on public property or someone else's property without permission to do so.

Report illegal dumping site:

To report an illegal dumping site, call 311 and give the address of the site.

Don't Dump In Birmingham Program

Beginning January 21, 2020, the City of Birmingham will make dumpsters available for residents to drop off mattresses, household garbage/refuse and trash and brush. No hazardous items nor commercial construction materials are permitted.

How to report an illegal dumper:

Take a picture or video of the person, vehicle and/or vehicle tag connected to the person performing the illegal act. Remember to be safe.

Take photos, video and other evidence of the illegal act to the magistrate's office at the Birmingham Municipal Court Services Building, which is next to the David J. Vann Municipal Justice Center, to swear out a summons or warrant. It is located at 808 18th Street North, Birmingham, AL 35203. The magistrate is available Monday – Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Penalties?

Offenders can face fines of up to \$1,000, community service and other penalties.
