Landfill Operating Procedures for Contractors in Birmingham (**New Georgia Landfill ONLY**)

Contractors and commercial carriers are required to complete a **Landfill User Permit Application** and **Waste Stream Certification** to dump at the **New Georgia Landfill**, until further notice. Forms are available at the New Georgia Landfill and the Eastern Area Landfill. Forms may also be found at [www.birminghamal.gov/illegaldumping](http://www.birminghamal.gov/illegaldumping).

Completed forms should be submitted to **Dan Johnson**, solid waste administrator at the Eastern Area Landfill, at [dan.johnson@birminghamal.gov](mailto:dan.johnson@birminghamal.gov).

The following tipping fees will be assessed:

- a. \$45/ton for municipal solid waste and construction and demolition debris carriers from outside the city
- b. \$30/ton for municipal solid waste and construction and demolition debris carriers from inside the city
- c. 50% discount for City of Birmingham weed abatement contractor debris, until further notice

1. The **Municipal Solid Waste Unit** accepts nonhazardous solid wastes, noninfectious putrescible and non-putrescible waste including but not limited to household garbage, industrial waste, commercial waste, paper and other similar type materials.
  - a. The **C&D Unit** accepts nonhazardous construction and demolition debris and rubbish
  - b. The **Brush Collection Area** accepts bulk trees, limbs and brush; no trash
  - c. The **Recyclable Scrap Metal Collection Area** accepts copper, aluminum, stainless steel, steel, tin, cast iron and old appliances for subsequent transport to a recycling contractor
2. The landfills **DO NOT** accept liquids (paint, oil, gas) or hazardous solid waste, compressed air containers, fluorescent bulbs, batteries, small engines, CFC container devices or ammunition.

**Landfill Operating Procedures for Residents**  
**(Eastern Area Landfill ONLY)**

Residents are permitted to dump at the Eastern Area Landfill’s Public Unloading Area, which is located at 2787 Alton Road in Birmingham.

1. There is no fee for residential disposal.
2. The public unloading area accepts:
  - a. Bagged household garbage & rubbish (refuse & litter), plastic appliances, furniture and other similar type materials.
  - b. Recyclable scrap metal: copper, aluminum, stainless steel, steel, tin, cast iron, cans and old metal appliances are collected and transported to a local metal recycler for processing.
  - c. Recyclable paper (bagged or boxed) such as newspapers, office paper, magazines, books, etc.
  - d. Recyclable plastics: soft drink/water bottles, fruit juice containers, cooking oil/salad dressing containers, milk jugs, cleaning agents, laundry detergent containers, bleaching agent containers, shampoo and conditioner bottles, and washing and shower soap containers.
3. The public unloading area **DOES NOT** accept liquids or hazardous solid waste, compressed air containers, computers, fluorescent bulbs, paint, tires, batteries, mattresses, construction or demolition waste (toilets, pipes, roofing, siding, ceiling tiles, carpet and flooring, insulation, etc.), bulk trees and brush, wooden doors, wooden pallets.
