What is the top source of credible information that will influence your decision to return to your regular routine?

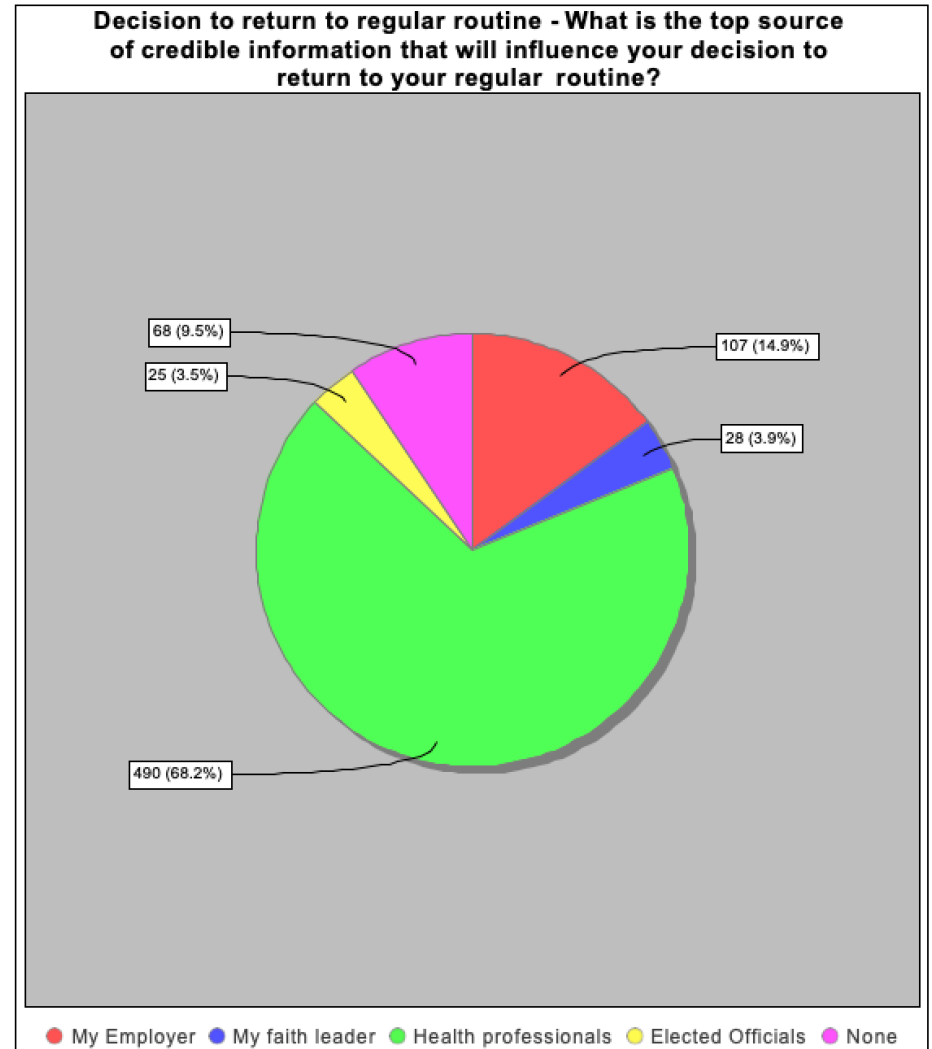
- My employer **107 (14.9%)**

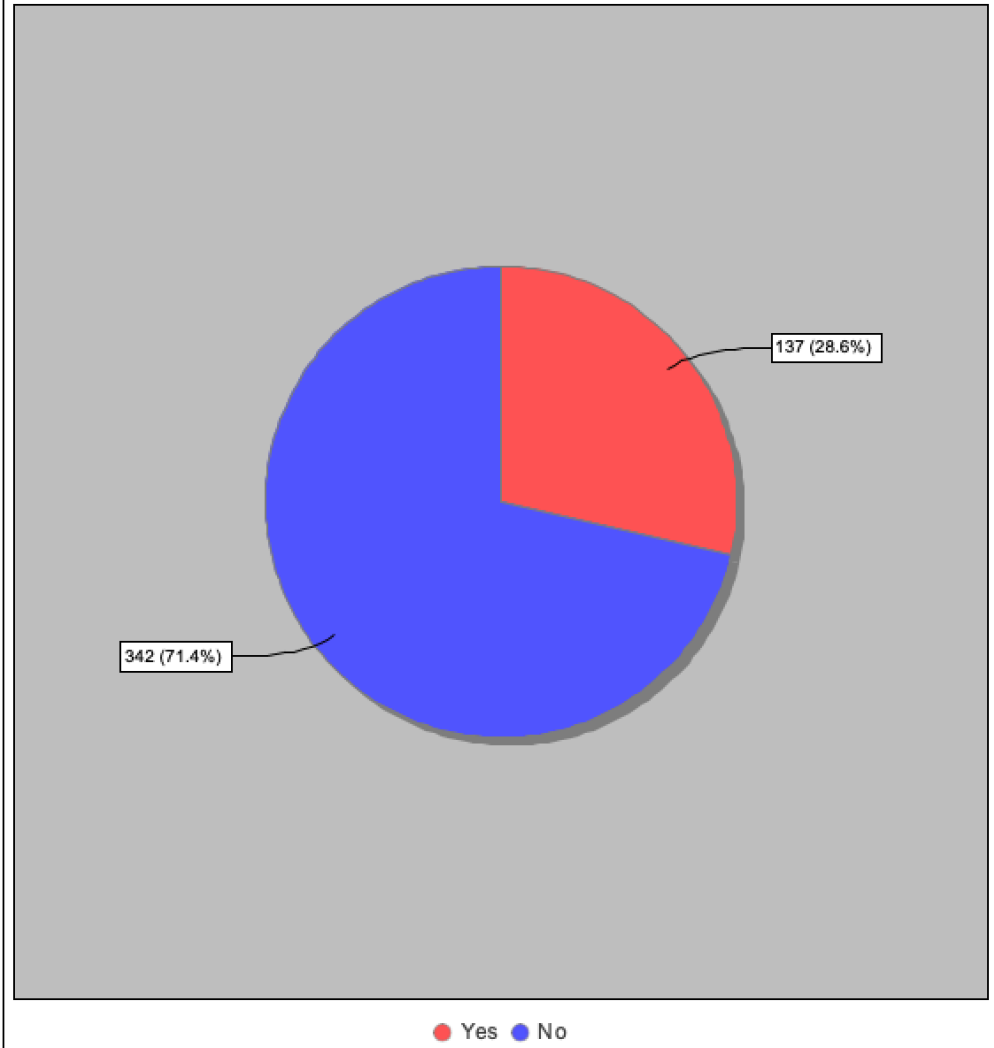

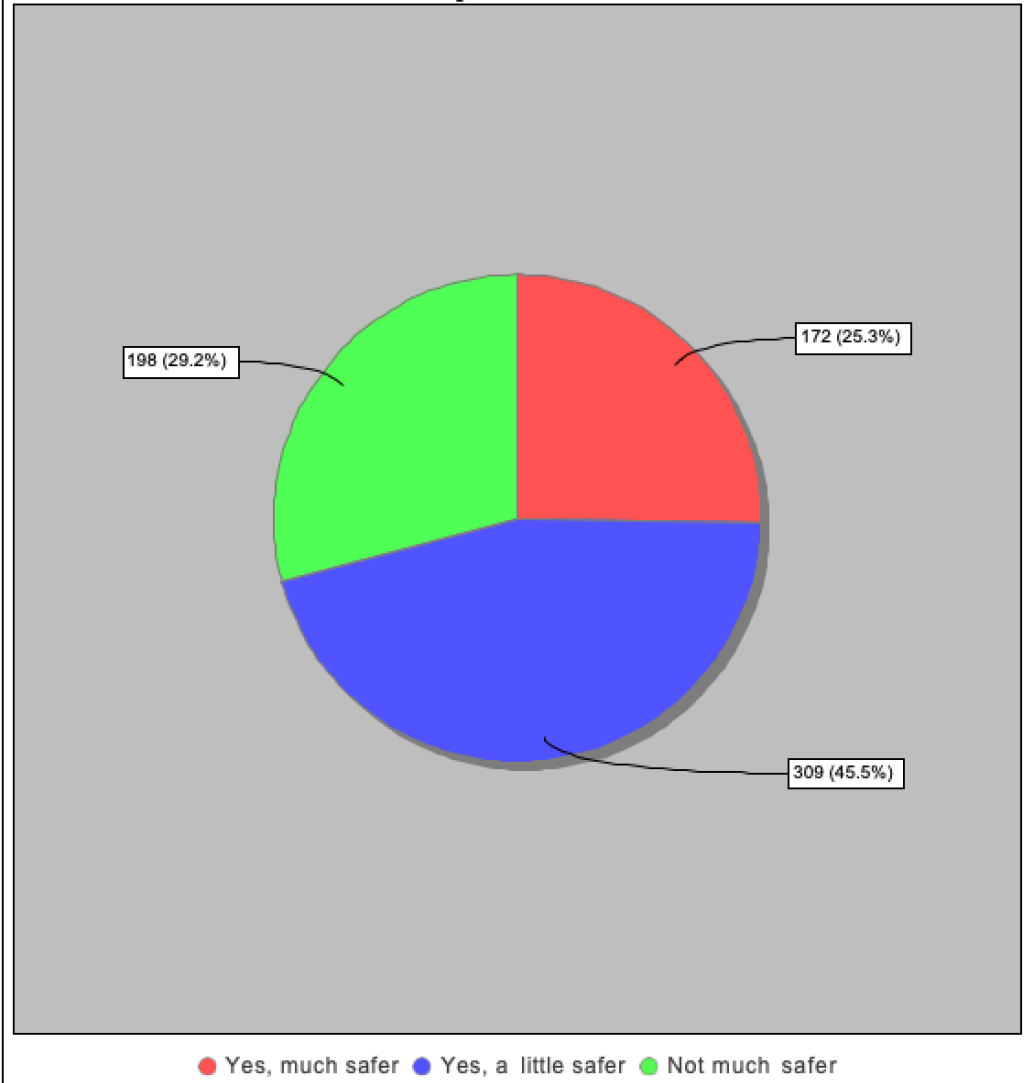
Does the new Face Coverings ordinance make you feel safer?

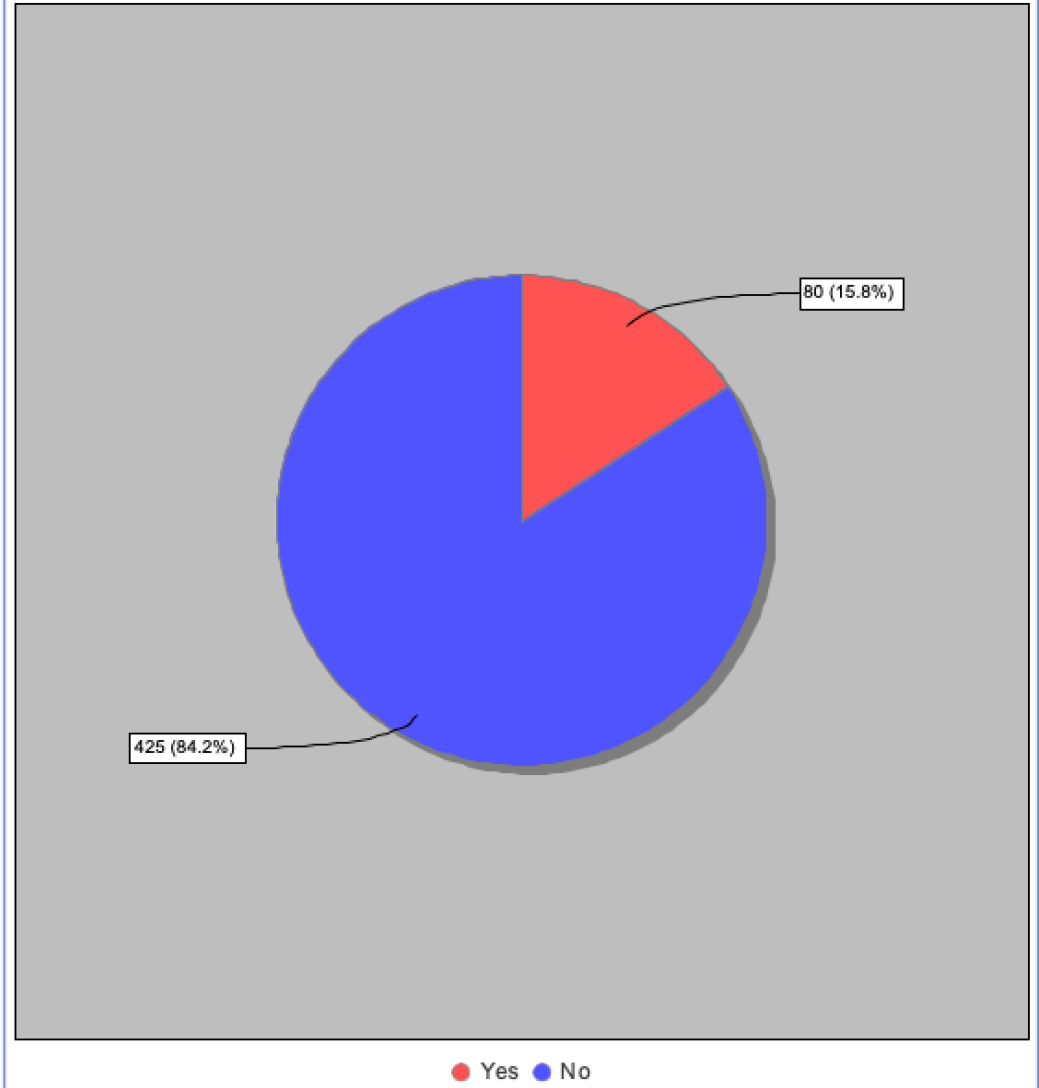

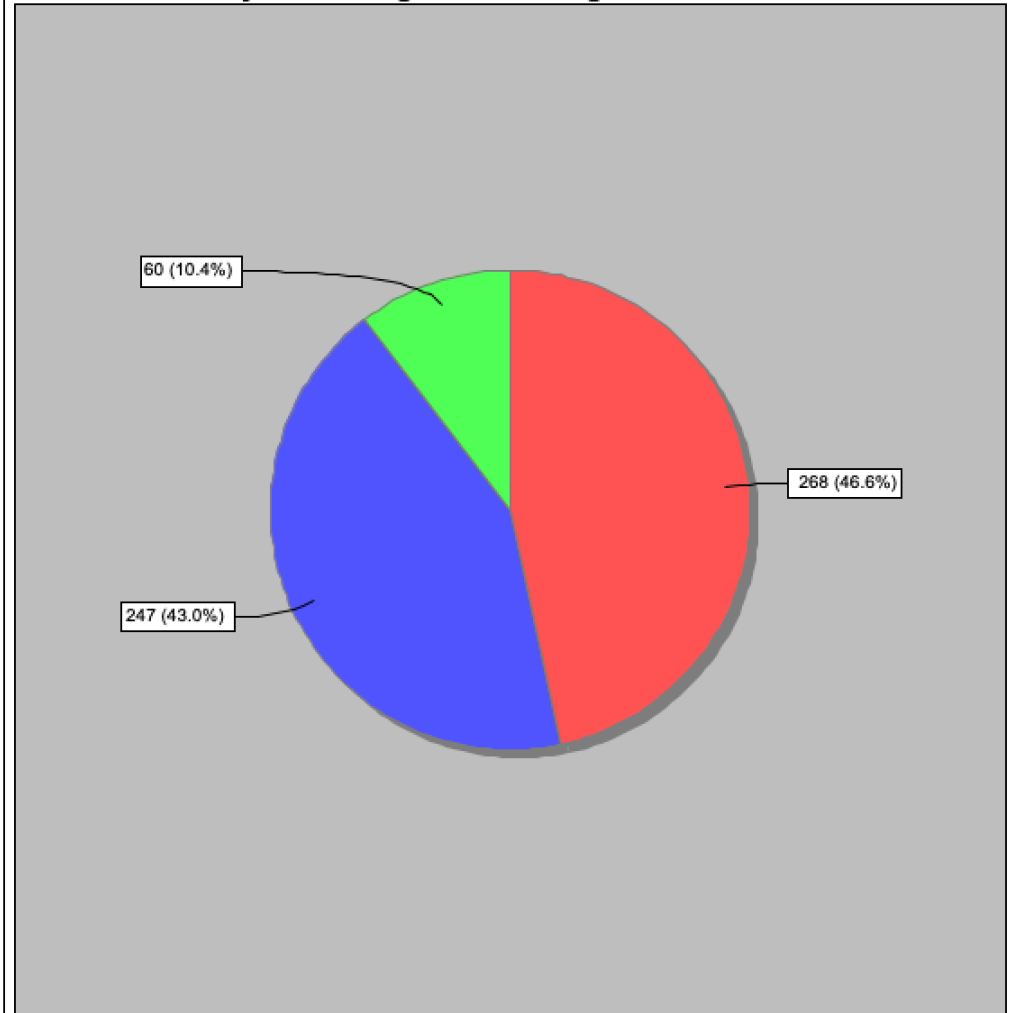
How is the leadership of Birmingham handling the COVID-19 crisis?
