EXCAVATIONS, SECTION 4-5-136

All permits required by this article shall be issued by the city engineer or his or her designee. A permit fee of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) shall be paid for each permit prior to issuance, provided that in the event construction has started before a written permit is granted, no permit shall be issued except upon payment of a fee of six hundred dollars (\$600.00). The provisions of this section shall apply to all persons alike, whether they are authorized by law or franchise to excavate in or under any of the streets or sidewalks of the city or not.

A Plan Review Fee shall also be required when plans are required to be reviewed before permit issuance. Plan Review Fees are due at the time of application.

Plan Review Fee:

Valuation	Fee
\$0-\$10,000.00.....	\$150.00
\$10,001.00-\$50,000.00.....	\$350.00
\$50,001.00-\$100,000.00.....	\$700.00
\$100,001.00.....	\$700.00 plus \$1.50 per \$1000.00 valuation for each \$1000.00 of the estimated value in excess of \$100,001.00

The applicant shall provide an estimated construction value at the time of application. Estimated cost shall include the total cost of all work and shall include overhead and profit, engineering and architectural design fees, and be equivalent to the end cost of the project. Detailed estimates and copy of the original executed contract(s) may be required for review to validate the declared scope and/or value of the construction. Final valuation shall be set by the City Engineer.
