RESOLUTION NO. 275-23

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Birmingham, Alabama that the Mayor be and hereby is authorized on behalf of the City of Birmingham, to execute any and all documents required for the City to complete and submit a grant application for U.S. Department of Transportation National Infrastructure Investments (i.e., the Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) Grant Program) under the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (“Bipartisan Infrastructure Law”), Amendment No. 2 for up to \$30,000,000.00 in funding to support an urban trail, Complete Street, and improved transit corridor with commitment of \$4,000,000 in matching funds from the City.
